## **Homographs**

A homograph is a word that is spelled the same as another word but has a different meaning. Some examples are **bow**, **read**, and **duck**. Use context to identify which meaning of the homograph is being used.

Read the homographs in the sentences below. Pick the meaning of the word from the two choices under the sentence. Circle the correct meaning.

1. We heard the phone ring loudly.

**ring:** an item to wear on a finger **ring:** a sound

2. Just then my brother bent to tie his shoe.

tie: an item to wear on your neck tie: the act of making a knot

3. Then I saw the school bus coming.

saw: past tense of see saw: to cut wood

4. My mom and dad walked over to wave good-bye to us.

wave: to move a hand back and forth wave: water rising up
